Lois Widly Student Scholarships To the Annual Conference

Lois Widly was a foundational member of International Nurses Society on Addictions and a tireless nurse leader. Lois inspired many within the organization to encourage students toward careers in addictions nursing. She was well known for her enthusiasm for education, and for convincing even the most hesitant members to actively use their talents to support the mission of IntNSA.

Lois specialized in the Addiction and Mental Health field. She worked in major hospital settings and had a private practice as an Addiction Interventionist for over 12 years.

During her active career, she was a staunch supporter of Addiction Nursing and served as president of the Consolidated Association of Nurses in Substance Abuse International (CANSAs). Ms. Widly was involved in the early formation of IntNSA through the collaboration of three separate nursing organizations. Thus, her influence is still felt today.

Up to four (4) Lois Widly Scholarships are awarded to nursing students each year. Ideally, two (2) of the scholarships are awarded to undergraduate and two (2) to graduate students. The award covers the cost of registration for the annual IntNSA conference and \$500 stipend. Deadline for applications is **June 30**.

Eligibility:

1. Current full time student in a nursing undergraduate or graduate program.
2. Must be sponsored by a current IntNSA member.
3. Must submit a second letter of recommendation from someone (a Professor, Dean, etc.) who can attest to the applicant's academic and scholarly suitability for this award.
